PHYSICAL STANDARD TEST (PST)

Candidates who qualify the PET will be screened for Height, Chest and Weight measurements. Those who do not meet the required physical measurements as applicable will be eliminated at this stage.

WRITTEN TEST

(The written test may be OMR based or Computer based at the discretion of ITBP).

The candidates who qualify PET & PST will have to appear in written examination.
